

- Partnering with UN Women, IFC, Columbia University, Bloomberg, LuxSE, GapSquare
- 73 participants in pilot sessions
 - o 27% were **men**
 - 37% were managers
 - 36% worked in sustainability
 - From 33 different countries





- 1. Finalized TCFD program (two 2-hour modules)
 - Partnering with CDSB, CDP, IFC and UNEP-FI
 - Sector (banks) and language adaptations (Spanish and Chinese)
 - 23,193 participants (54% female; from 150 countries)
 - Wins Climate Finance Award
- 2. Introduced new ISSB program (3.5 hours + homework)
 - Partnering with IFRS Foundation and IFC
 - **644 participants** in first 3 sessions held (41% women; from 22 countries)
- 3. Introduced new GRI training (two 1.5 hour modules)
 - Partnering with GRI
 - **508 participants** in pilot sessions (35% women)


